

Printable Measuring Tape | Made Easy for You by National Tuxedo Rentals

1. Carefully cut along the black outer lines of each strip, until you have 9 individual strips.
2. You can apply a very small amount of glue to the shaded area, use tape, or staples to join the ends of your strips.
3. To ensure proper order, the markers should match when joined - looking like a little bowtie with identical letters.
